- Started Bell with just one product: Rodent Cake
- 1976 Bell moves to rented facility in Madison, WI for increased office, manufacturing and laboratory space
- 1979 Bell purchases and moves into current corporate headquarters





# **ORIGINAL RODENTICIDES**

- Bell's 1st product Rodent Cake:
- Active 1st gen. AVK Warfarin
- · UW-Madison discovery and patent of warfarin in 1941
- Bell took that active and made our first successful rodenticide
- Bell's 2nd product PCQ:
- Active was second-generation anticoagulant
  Diphacinone
- Introduced in 1975

- 260,000 sq. ft. manufacturing, laboratory and office space








